

Internet Use Policy in the IT Lab

1. **Appropriate use of the Internet is to aid teaching and learning.**
 - a. You will primarily be using the Internet for research and discovery.
 - b. You will not use the Internet for downloading programs, playing games, streaming music, visiting chat rooms or checking email.

2. **Internet use is by permission only.**
 - a. Students working on the following modules have permission to use the Internet at their module at any time to complete class work:
 - Working with the Internet
 - Investigating the Internet
 - Web Page Design
 - b. Other students will not have Internet access except for special class projects.
 - c. Exception: Free computer time is sometimes earned as a reward for good work!

3. **Monitoring Internet Use**
 - a. The instructor will use software in the lab to monitor computer and Internet use.

4. **Consequences**
 - a. 1st offense: warning and working detention after school on Wednesdays
 - b. 2nd offense: phone call home
 - c. 3rd offense: referral to office with recommendation to drop from IT program
